### Lucky Charms Treats

#### Ingredients

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, plus more for pan.
- 1 (12 oz) bag mini marshmallows
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 6 cups Lucky Charms

#### Directions

1. Grease a 9" x 9" baking dish with butter.

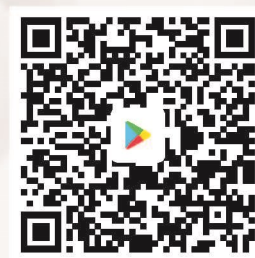

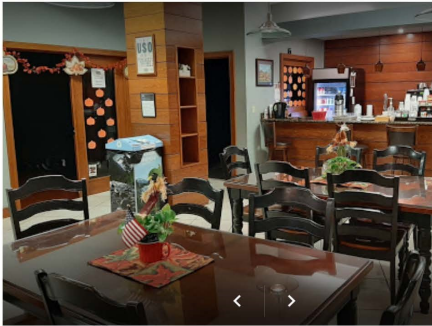
