RECIPE CORNER

Apple Crisp

Ingredients

10 cups all-purpose apples, peeled, cored and sliced

1 cup white sugar

1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degree C)
- 2. Place the sliced apples in a 9x13 inch pan. Mix the white sugar, 1 tablespoon flour and ground cinnamon together, and sprinkle over apples. Pour water evenly over all.
- 3. Combine the oats, 1 cup flour, brown sugar, baking powder, baking soda and melted butter together. Crumble evenly over the apple mixture.
- 4. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for about 45 minutes.
