MAINTENANCE CORNER

We're creeping up on the winter season, so here are a few things to keep in mind when temperatures reach 32 degrees and lower to help prevent pipes from freezing in your home. NEVER turn your heat off, under any circumstance. Set your thermostat no lower than 65 degrees, even if you are planning on going out of town or leaving for more than 24 hours. This is to ensure your pipes do not freeze and burst. Keep your garage door completely closed when not in use. Let your faucets drip in the kitchen and bathrooms to keep a constant flow to help with the prevention of pipes freezing.
