News Flash

During the holidays, cooking related activities are the leading cause of home fires and the 2nd leading cause of home fire deaths in the U.S. Here are a few tips to keep your family safe! Set a timer to alert you of your cooking. Stay close by and limit multi-tasking while engaging in cooking activities. Check food frequently when it's on the stovetop. Keep dishtowels and potholders away from the stove. When frying turkeys outdoors, keep a minimum of 15' from any building structure as well as any parked cars. Never disconnect your smoke detectors. November is the perfect time to change out the batteries in your detectors. Ideally, you should change out your batteries at the start and stop of daylight savings time. Now that Daylight Savings ends on November 6th at 2:00 a.m. Remember to change out your batteries and you'll be all set for that Holiday cooking and baking!
